Chuck Schumer), and the US House of Representatives Education and Work Force Committee (apptd. by Rep. Bill Clay). Mr. Flannery served as Special Counsel for the Minority during the Impeachment of President Bill Clinton, and Chief of Staff for Congresswoman Zoe Lofgren, handling hi-tech and leadership issues.

Mr. Flannery was a senior associate for Poletti Friedin Prashker Feldman & Gartner in New York, and secured a multi-million dollar settlement from PATCO in the wake of the air traffic controllers strike; Mr. Flannery had his own practice in the past, and became "Of Counsel" to CMZ in September 2002.
